Cameron first joined the Oshawa Community Credit Union as a high school co-op student and was later hired as a part-time teller to support the operation during school breaks and holidays. In 2017, Cameron was selected to serve as an Associate Director of the Board and in 2018 he was elected by the membership to serve as a full Director. In this role Cameron has completed many Director training courses and served on many committees including both the Planning and Budget Committee and Audit Committee where he is currently Chair. Last year, in 2025, Cameron completed the ICD-Rotman Director's Education Program and earned his ICD.D corporate governance designation from the Institute of Corporate Directors.

In the financial services sector Cameron works as an Investment Analyst for Vision Capital Corporation, a real estate investment fund managing approximately \$800 Million in investor funds. In this role Cameron has managed investments across all property types in Canada and the United States and has had exposure to all aspects of the real estate industry including lending, purchase and sale transactions, construction, asset management, capital raising and corporate strategy. Cameron regularly interacts with company management teams and corporate directors/trustees at the governance level. This experience helps Cameron guide the Credit Union from a business perspective for both short-term and long-term planning.

Prior to Oshawa Community Credit Union, Cameron served as a director of a large Mississauga condo corporation for many years overseeing both capital planning and reserve fund management. In this role Cameron worked with engineers, lawyers, property managers and construction firms to manage large construction contracts covering over 100 homes.

Cameron is a graduate of the business program at the Rotman School of Management and received the distinction of being a Dean's List Scholar. Cameron has also completed his Chartered Financial Analyst designation.
